

# October 29, 2023 Inside Out

Luke 12:8-12

#### Words are visible manifestations of one's interior and they carry impactful power

Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks: Matt 12:33-37; 15:11, 17-19
The precedent of creation: Genesis 1; The tongue boasts great things: James 3:5,7-8;
Sword thrusts or healing: Proverbs 12:18; 18;21; Every careless word: Matthew 12:36

## There are different classes of sins according to the intention/posture of the heart

Unintentional sins: instinctive, reactionary, rooted in ignorance: Leviticus 4:2; 5:1-7

Simply intentional sins: rooted in weakness: Leviticus 6:1-7

Defiant (high-handed) intentional sins: calculated, committed; pride: Numbers 15:30, Deuteronomy 17:12

#### Understanding Denying Jesus and Blaspheming the Spirit in Light of These Two Big Ideas

Jesus as a wisdom teacher; the mashal more principle than technical

Verbal confession as reflecting heart condition: Romans 10:10; 1 John 2:23

Verbal confession reveals the Holy Spirit in a person: 1 Corinthians 12:3; Matthew 16:16-17; 1 John 4:2-3,15

This is not referring to a rash word in a bad moment: Leviticus 5:4; 2 Timothy 2:12-12

One who confesses Jesus is an authentic disciple; denies: high-handed rejecter of Jesus: Luke 12:8-10

(This does not preclude someone who confesses falsely): Matthew 15:8

One who speaks a word against the Son of Man: unintentional sin/ignorance: Luke 23:24

Blaspheme the Holy Spirit: high-handed defiance against Jesus and His movement

Where there is no forgiveness implies there is no longer repentance: see Hebrews 6:4-6

Connected to the Belzebul conversations: Matthew 12:22-32

Resisting the Holy Spirit in Acts 7:51; outraging the Spirit in Hebrews 10:26-31

This verse also serves as a window into the nature of the Trinitarian relationship

#### Given You What to Say: Luke 12:11-12

You can trust words to come out of what is real within you Don't be afraid of succumbing to denial; trust you will have what you need in the moment And your words will have Holy Spirit impact when they come

### Every human everywhere with every action is either moving toward or away from God

Come all who are weary/thirsty: Matthew 11:28; John 7:37; But you were not willing: Matthew 23:37

C.S. Lewis: Two people in the end: Thy will be done, or thy will be done

No journey is the same (Moses, Solomon, Judas, Peter, Ananias, Paul, the Prodigal Son): Matt 21:28-32

A humble and contrite heart, You will not despise: Psalm 51:17

God resists the proud but draws near to the humble: 1 Peter 5:5; James 4:6
