Sourced in a Latin Medieval carol about the Annunciation called Angelus ad Virginem. 1200-1300 A Basque carol, collected by french teacher, composer, ethnomusicologist Charles Borde Translated into English by the English priest and scholar Sabine Baring-Gould (1834-1924) Based on a traditional Basque tune and arranged by Edgar Pettman in 1922 in University Carol Book

#### Yes as the Cornerstone of All Discipleship

"To me be as it pleases God"

Responding as opposed to initiating: God has the best ideas

Attentiveness, willingness, faithfulness

God leads to the brink of a step to be taken, rarely with a view around the bend

Struggles allowed: parable of the two sons: Matthew 21:28-32

Mistakes allowed: GPS

### Variations of Yes in the Bible

Moses: The reluctant yes (I don't think I am the right person for the job): Exodus 4:1-17

Isaiah: The grateful yes (what else can I say in light of all you have done?): Isaiah 6:1-8

Jonah: The chastised yes (this is certainly better than the alternative): Jonah 3:3

Paul: The overwhelmed yes (I am utterly compelled; I cannot imagine now doing otherwise): Acts 9:1-22

Mary: the puzzled yes ( I do not understand but I will trust): Luke 1:26-28

### The Ultimate Yes of Jesus

Yes from the beginning: Revelation 13:8; Philippians 2:5-7

His earthly ministry characterized by the absolute yes: John 5:19-20; Hebrews 10:5-7

The bookends of the Temptation and Gethsemane: Luke 4:1-13 and 22:39-46

His "yes" leads to God's "yes" for the world: 2 Corinthians 1:20

Our "yes" in imitation: the Revelation and the revelation
